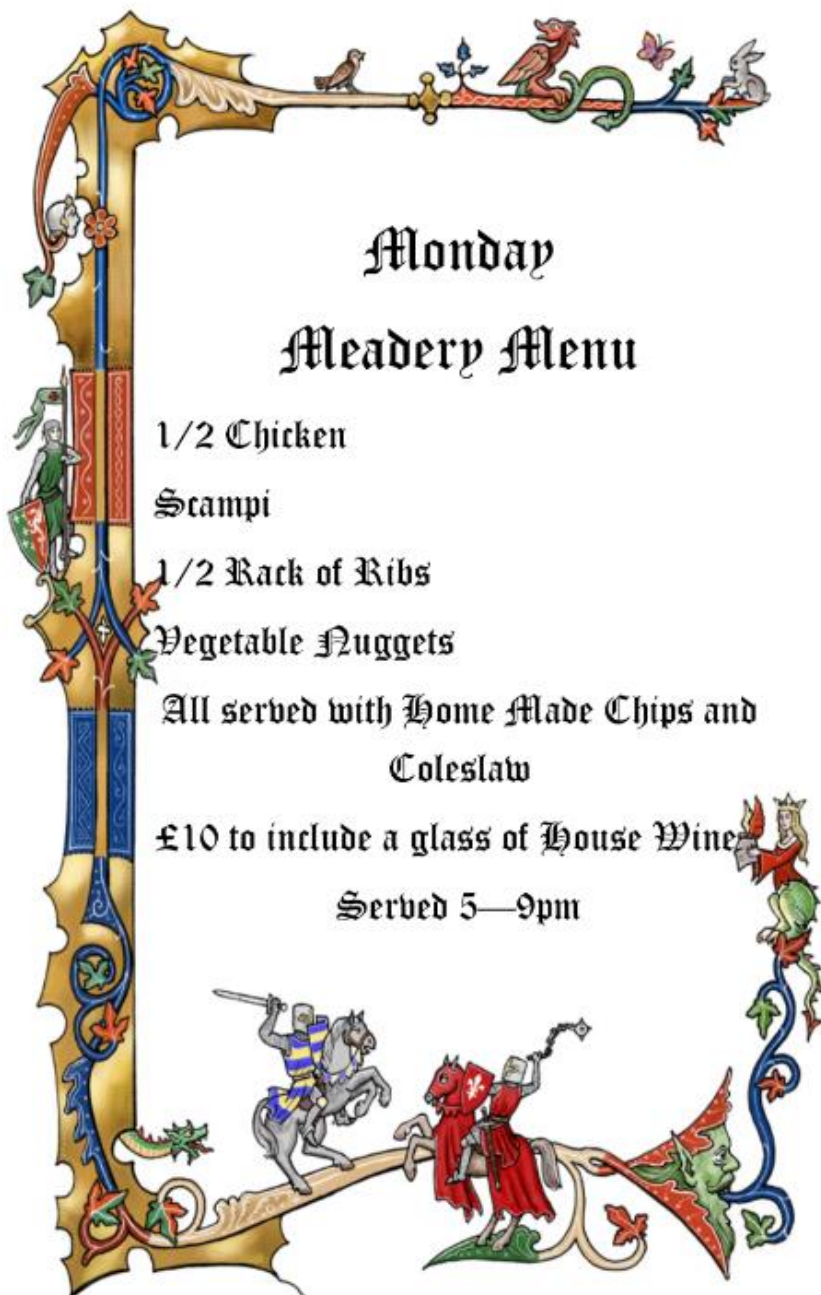
Food is served on Mondays from 12 noon to 2.30pm with our Meadery Menu served in the evening from 5 to 9pm. Our full menu is available Tuesday to Saturday from 12 noon to 9pm and on Sunday we serve our Carvery from 12 to 6pm. We have a couple of additional items on our menu. Have you tried our Baked Camembert Garland? A deliciously gooey camembert surrounded by a home made tear and share bread with a caramelised red onion and balsamic filling. Our Mixed Grill is a hungry man's feast with steak, gammon, pork chop, lamb chop, 2 sausages, liver and 2 free range eggs served with tomato, mushrooms, onion rings and chips. A rack of pork ribs smothered in barbecue sauce and served with homemade coleslaw and chips are also now on offer at only £12. And we are now serving fresh fish specials at all times. Fresh fish is delivered on a daily basis, so if you are a fish lover check out our fish specials boards. Mussels, sardines, hake and crab are among some of the varieties we have on offer. Teas, coffees and cakes are available at all times and between 11am to 12 noon Monday to Saturday our coffee and cake deal is only £3.95. Not forgetting our Cream Teas. Home made scones with strawberry jam and lashings of Clotted Cream washed down with a nice cup of tea served in a china cup and saucer.

August's "Cocktail of the Month" was very popular with many of you, but in case you are now looking for something different we have a new one for September. How about an Aperol Negroni? Shots of Aperol and Sweet Vermouth poured over ice, topped with soda water and slices of orange and once again this is available at any time for £5.

On Friday 20th September we will be holding our Coffee Morning in aid of Macmillan Cancer Support. Starting at 10.30am and ending when we sell out of cakes. We will have a range of homemade cakes for sale either to eat here with a cup of coffee or tea, or to take away for later.
